Requirements

Introduction This section covers the requirements for volunteers within SFS Types of There are two types of volunteer: volunteer 1. Those participating in sailing activities on water. 2. Those participating in social activities or onboard the ferry. **Training Stage** For training purposes, volunteers need not have membership of SFS. During the training however, they should be registered for insurance purposes. Volunteer Any volunteer who is participating in the sailing program, must be a member Type 1 (Sailing or Social) of SFS. A register should be kept for each event, and the volunteer should sign the register each time they participate in an activity. Type 1 activities might include, but is not limited to, rescue crew, starting boat, etc. Volunteer A volunteer who is participating in social activities does not have to be a Type 2 member of SFS. They should however be encouraged to join the club. It is also necessary to complete a register for Type 2 volunteers.

Type 2 activities might include, but is not limited to, ferry commentary, BBQ, etc.

Unless a person has filled out a register, they are not covered by club insurance.
